- Acetaminophen Syrup for Children (Tylenol equivalent)
- Clotrimazole cream 1% (Lotrimin equivalent)
- Hemorrhoid Cream (Preparation-H equivalent)
- Hydrocortisone Cream 1% (Benadryl, Cortizone-10 equiv.)
- Ibuprofen Syrup for Children (Motrin, Advil equivalent)
- Low-Dose / Children’s Aspirin – 81 mg.
- Multivitamins: Adult, Children’s Gummie and Chewable
- Muscle Rub Cream (Ben Gay equivalent)
- Triple Antibiotic Ointment (Neosporin equivalent)
